

National Tree Strategy (Westminster Hall)

Dan Jarvis Sheffield City Reginal Mayor addressing the National Tree Strategy on Wednesday 16th December 2020, highlighted two major factors facing not only the UK but the whole planet: Climate change and biodiversity. Trees harness the power to overcome both of these challenges and he quoted an ancient Chinese proverb “The best time to plant a tree was 20 years ago, the second time is now”. Despite all the well documented evidence on the significance of trees and climate Mr. Jarvis stressed the UK does not have enough and does not adequately look after the ones we have.
